

# **Module Catalogue**

The following sections give an overview on the available modules. In the first column, you can find the long name and the abbreviation of the modules. The number of ECTS points can be found in column 2 and column 3 specifies the number of semesters of the courses. In the last column, there are additional hints on the type of courses, if it is graded and if the module is split into submodules. F. e. "Educational Psychology" (06-PSY-PAPSY) compromises two different modules that can be attended independently from each other. And both modules again include two different courses each.

Most modules include two different courses (e.g., a lecture and a seminar) and all modules are taught every term. The concrete name of the seminar might vary from term to term and usually, there are several different parallel groups for the seminar of a module. 

## Finding the Courses in the Course Catalogue


The course catalogue is available online via WueStudy. Usually the courses are made public in the midterm of the following semester (e. g. at the beginning of June for the following winter term and in January for the summer term). Please visit <a href="https://wuestudy.zv.uni-wuerzburg.de/">https://wuestudy.zv.uni-wuerzburg.de/</a> to retrieve the courses. You do not need to log in the system to find information on the courses. For the enrollment, you need a university account, which you receive after coming to Würzburg.

**Step 1**First, enter the course catalogue and maybe switch to English language.




#### Step 2

Please choose the correct semester in the course catalogue. You can choose between winter term (beginning in October) and summer term (beginning in April).




#### Step 3


Now you have to choose between Bachelor ("Grundständige Studiengänge (Bachelor, ...)") or Master degree ("Master- und Aufbaustudiengänge"). After clicking on the degree, you first get a list of courses of different studies, choose "Psychologie" and next "Bachelor (180 ECTS) Psychologie – 2015" or, if you chose "Master- und Aufbaustudiengänge", "Master (120 ECTS) Psychologie – 2015".



Now you first see the main categories of the courses ("Compulsory courses", "Compulsory electives", ...). By clicking through the categories you will find the courses, f. e. the course "Motivation and Emotion"  $\rightarrow$  seminar "Aggression and Violence".



By clicking on the course, you will get further information, f. e. if the course is held in English or at what time the parallel groups are taking place:



## Step 4

Click on the modules you are interested in and you either get the submodules or the concrete courses. Navigate through the courses in order to plan your stay. Most courses are held each semester, but the times and persons may vary. Please do not forget to come to Würzburg in time in order to be able to register for the courses you want.
